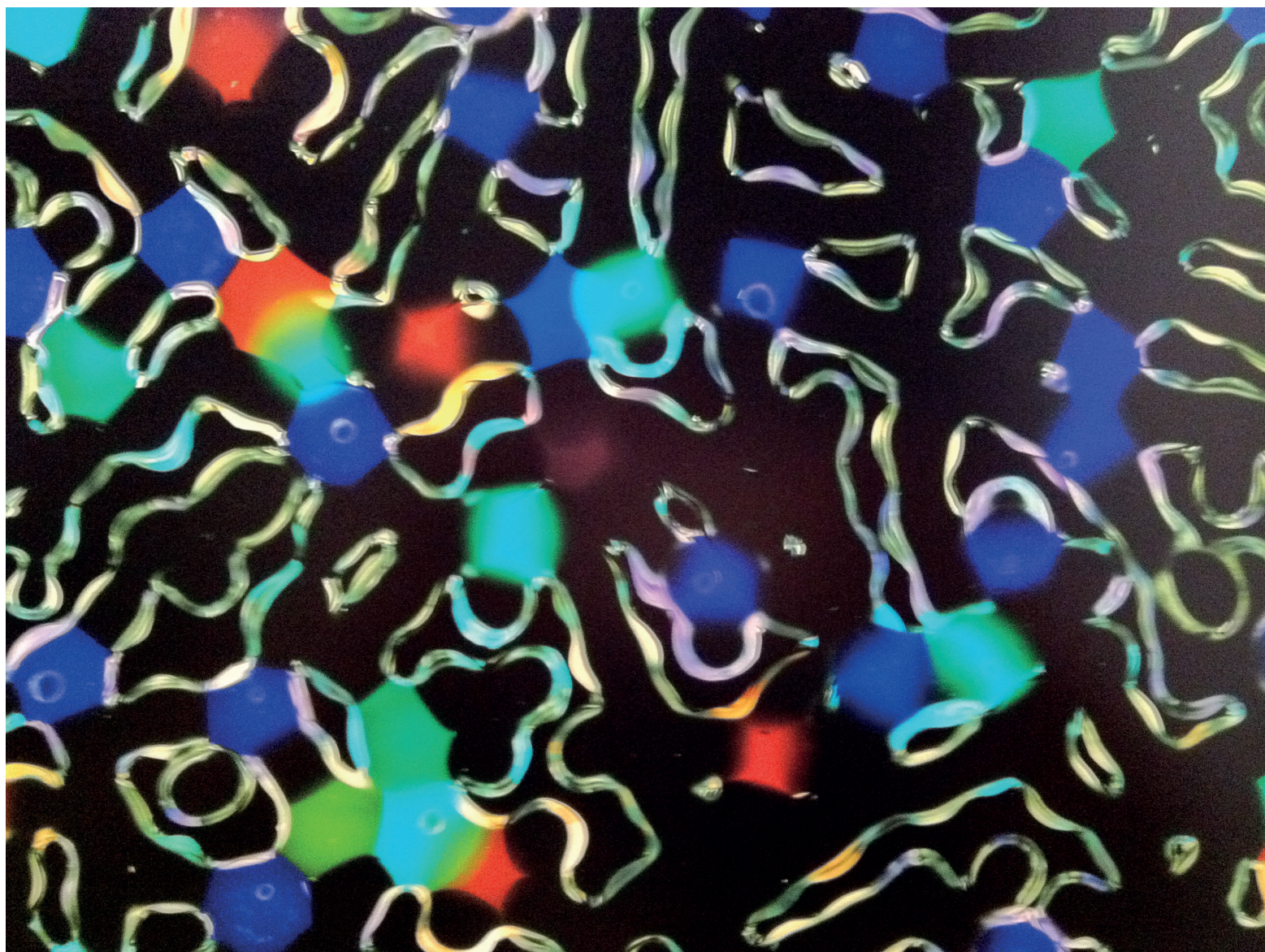


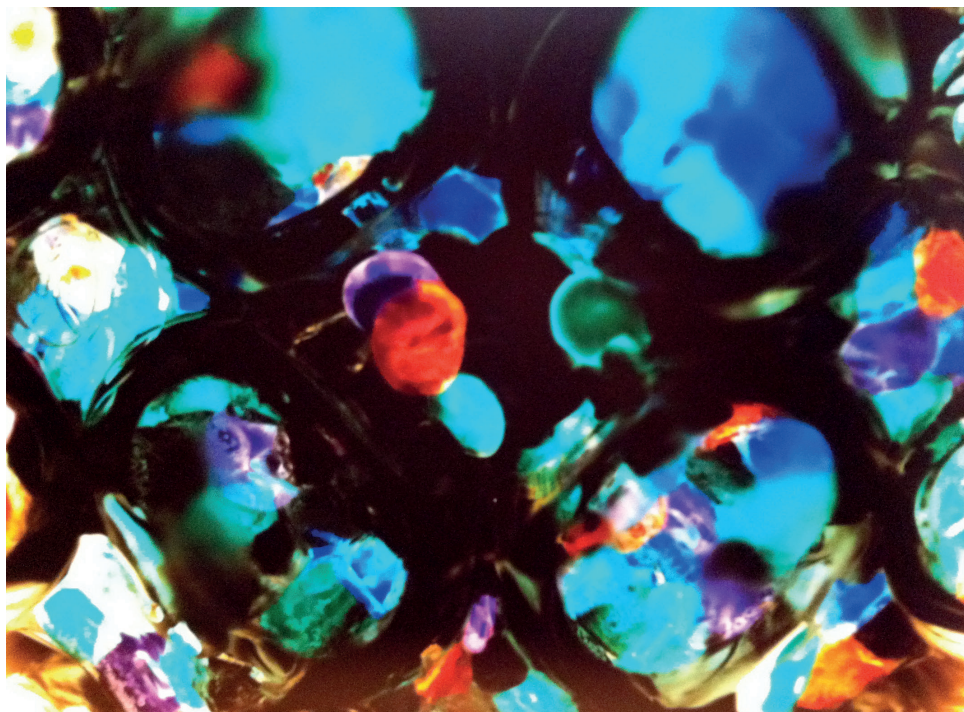
PHOTOGRAPHIC TRANSLATION 2010/11

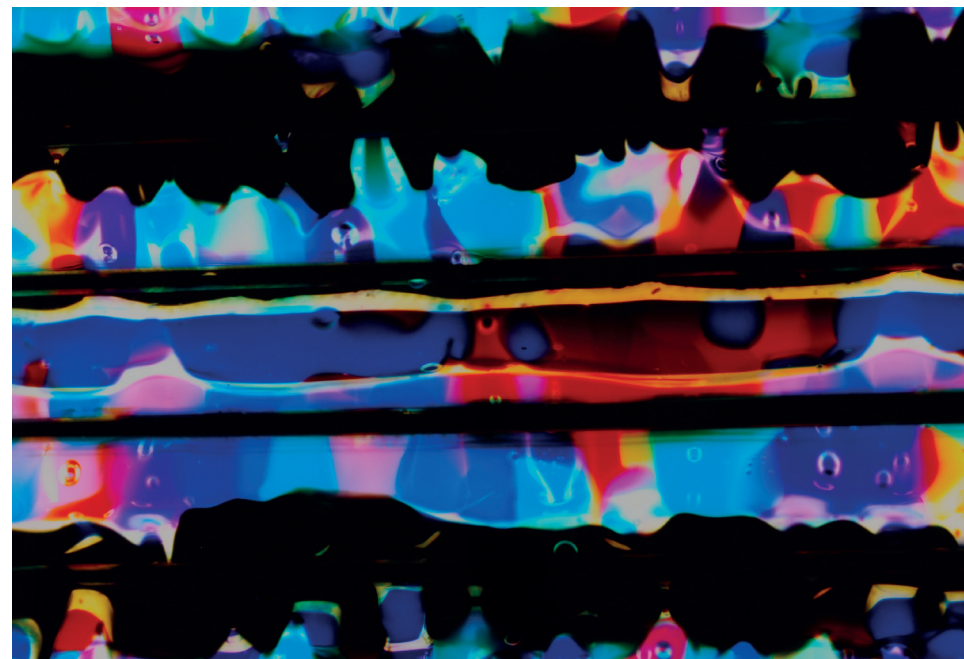
